ZANZIBAR – Island of Spice | Stone Town | Prison Island | Chumbe Island | Beaches |

Day 1: Arrival ZNZ Airport

Upon arrival in ZNZ airport meet and greet with driver then transfer to North/North-East Coast to your hotel* for overnight on Full Board Basis.

Day 2 – 3 : North / North-East Coast

Days at leisure at your hotel in the North / North-East Coast on Full Board Basis. Relax and unwind by the Indian Ocean.







Day 4: Spice Tour + Stone Town Shopping

After breakfast, go for a Spice Tour; here you can see, touch a wide variety of spices, fruits, herbs and ornamental plants and flowers. You will also have the opportunity to pick, smell, and savor fruits and spices which you have probably never seen on the supermarket shelf, Cloves, star fruit, tangerine trees, lemon grass, mangos teen, 'lipstick trees', to name but a few what you can expect to see! This is the cheapest place to buy locally made perfumes and oils. The Stone Town of Zanzibar is a fine example of the Swahili coastal trading towns of East Africa. It retains its urban fabric and townscape virtually intact and contains many fine buildings that reflect its particular culture, which has brought together and homogenized disparate elements of the cultures of Africa, the Arab region, India, and Europe over more than a millennium. Spend the afternoon walking around this UNESCO Heritage Site and shop through these narrow streets. Dinner and Overnight at hotel*.





Day 5 : Prison Island + Historical City Tour

After breakfast you will be taken to the beautiful island off the Zanzibar Town. The use of the island has changed overtime. Although it was originally built as a prison it was never put into that function. Later it was used as a quarantine of slaves for the whole of East Africa. The remnants of the built are still visible. There is very beautiful minor sandy beach where swimming on the crystal waters is marvelous. This is also a home of the giant tortoise, which is now under strict conservation.

After Sight-seeing on Prison Island, head to the hotel for lunch and from here you will then proceed to the Anglican Cathedral at Mkunazini built by Bishop Streers in 1874 exactly on the site of the former slave market. The guide will also show you the place where is believed that slaves were kept before auctioned. The crucifix of the Church came from the tree in Chitambo under which the heart of Dr. Livingstone was buried. Later, Dinner and Overnight at Hotel*.





Day 6 : Chumbe Island + Forodhani

Chumbe Island Coral Park is an award-winning private nature reserve that was developed from 1991 for the conservation and sustainable management of uninhabited Chumbe Island off Zanzibar, one of the last pristine coral islands in the region. The reserve includes a fully protected Coral Reef Sanctuary where you have a chance to snorkel and see the diverse coral life.

After snorkeling, head back to Stone town and explore the night food experience of fresh sea-food at Forodhani Gardens. Overnight at hotel*.



Day 7 : Transfer to ZNZ Airport

After Breakfast, transfer to ZNZ Airport for your flight back home.
